

March 26, 2025 — Headline Set

1. Clone Reagan broadcasts a duet with Hologram Gorbachev.
2. Prince disappears mid-solo in Geneva; only glitter remains.
3. Superman lands on a Soviet sub in the Arctic Circle.

4. The Pope issues a call to 'protect the mirrors.'

March 27, 2025 — Headline Set
